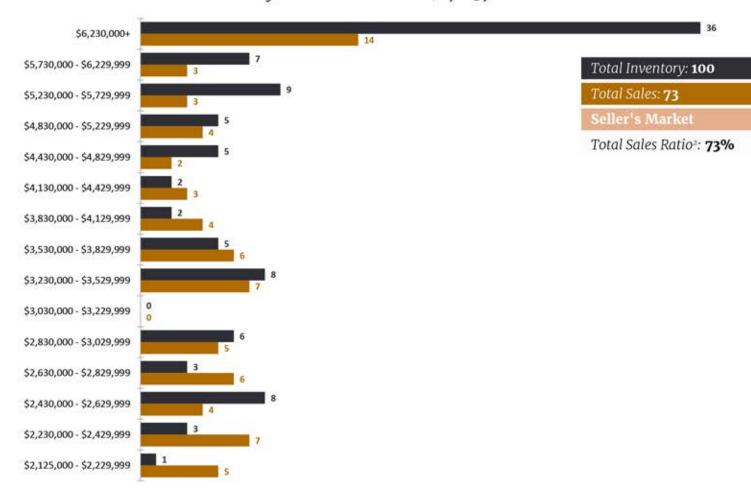

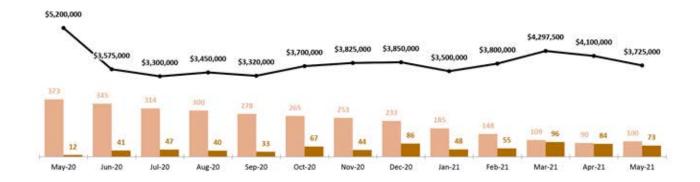

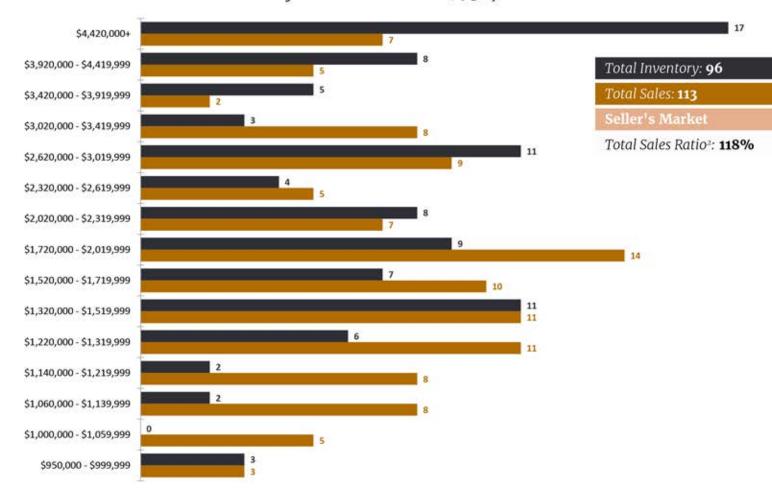
NAPLES MARKET SUMMARY | MAY 2021

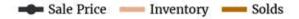

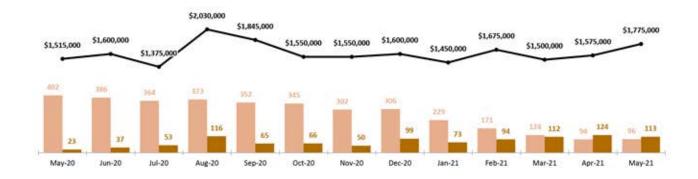
