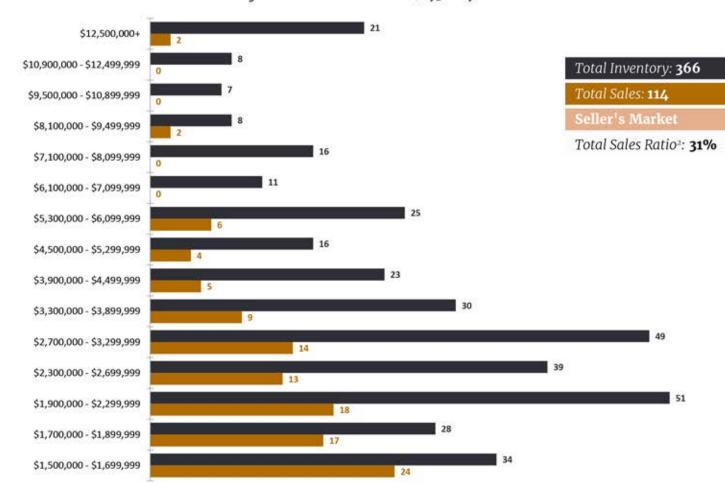

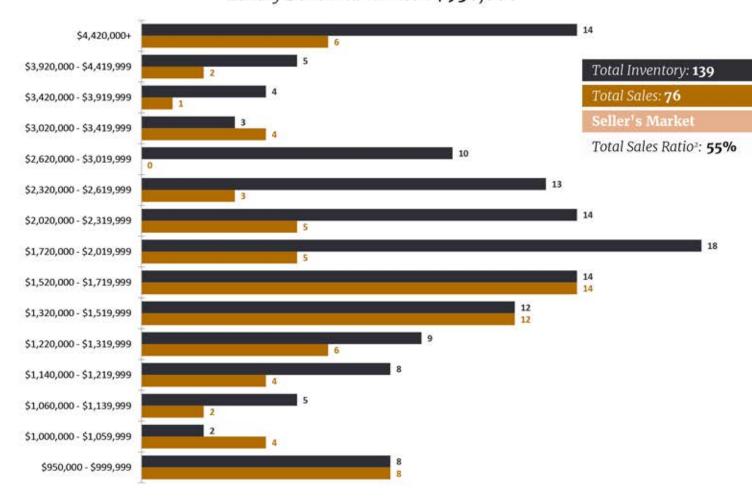
NAPLES MARKET SUMMARY | SEPTEMBER 2021

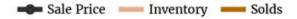

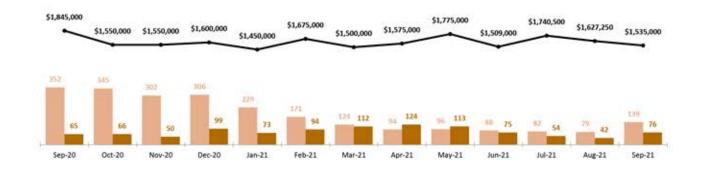
