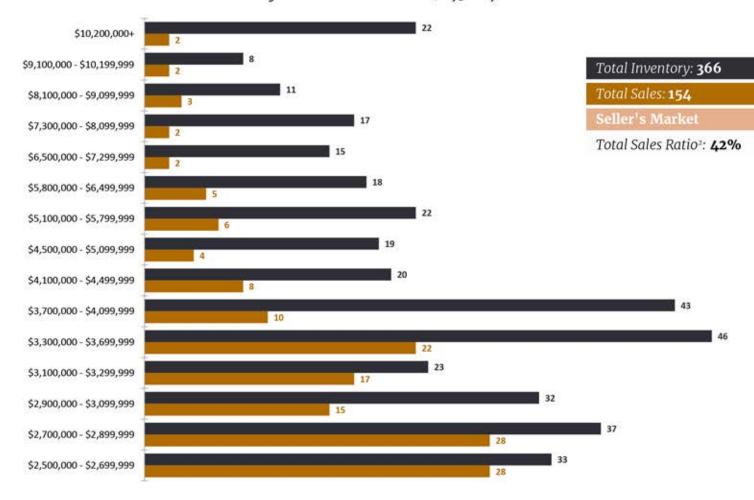

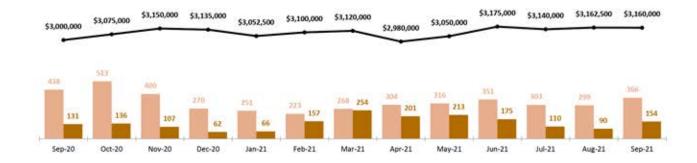

- The Toronto single-family luxury market is a Seller's Market with a 42% Sales Ratio.
- Homes sold for a median of 99.69% of list price in September 2021.
- The most active price band is \$2,500,000-\$2,699,999, where the sales ratio is 85%.
- The median luxury sales price for single-family homes is \$3,160,000.
- The median days on market for September 2021 was 7 days, down from 12 in September 2020.

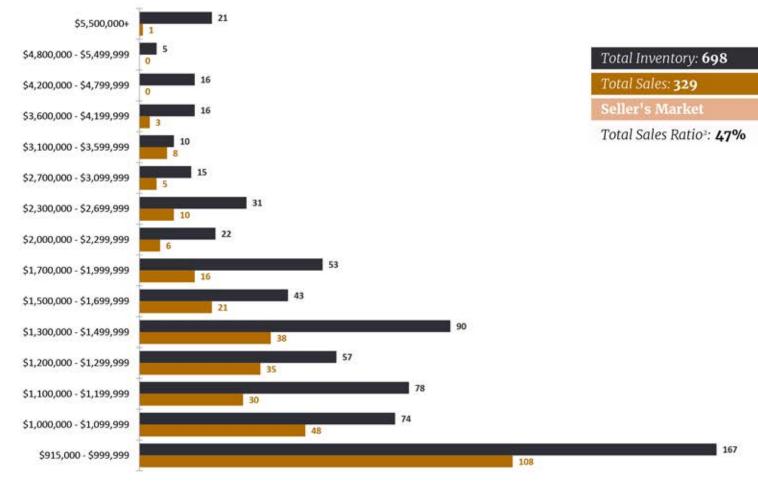

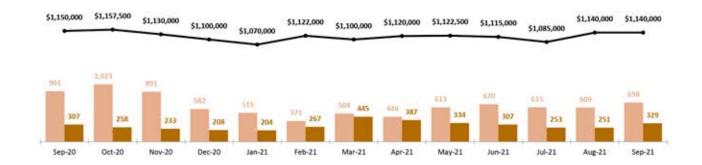

- Homes sold for a median of 99.63% of list price in September 2021.
- The most active price band is \$3,100,000-\$3,599,999, where the sales ratio is 80%.
- The median luxury sales price for attached homes is \$1,140,000.
- The median days on market for September 2021 was 8 days, down from 9 in September 2020.
