## **ROSEPHANYE POWELL**

Dr. Rosephanye Powell is a renowned composer and conductor. Her works have premiered at Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, and Spivey Hall, and have been commissioned by Chanticleer and other notable ensembles. Dr. Powell composes for university choruses, professional, community, and church choirs, and secondary school choruses.

Her compositions are in high demand at choral festivals and conventions, including the American Choral Directors Association. Dr. Powell serves as Professor of Voice at Auburn University, holding degrees from Florida State, Westminster Choir College, and Alabama State. Her research focuses on African-American spirituals and voice care. As a sought-after clinician, conductor, and adjudicator, Dr. Powell travels nationally and internationally, presenting lectures, workshops, and festivals. Her work has been auctioned by Chorus America, solidifying her reputation as a leading composer.



Rosephanye Powell has been awarded the 2025 Brock Commission to premiere at the American Choral Directors Assocation's 2025 National Conference in Dallas, Texas.

The Raymond W. Brock Memorial Choral Series was established in 1991 to commemorate the life and legacy of Raymond W. Brock, who served ACDA from 1987 until his passing in 1991. Each year, the ACDA Composition Initiatives Committee selects a composer to receive a prestigious commission, funded by the Raymond W. Brock Memorial Endowment.
