


ABOUT ELENA SHARKOVA



Treble choirs will love the ethereal harmonies and effective voice-leading in this beautiful song of hopes and dreams. Easy to Medium.






Bedu Paku Baramasa -SA Divisi

This energetic Himalayan folksong has a timeless message and catchy melody. Accessible for children's choirs, its canonic structure is easy to learn.




