
#### **ABOUT JULIE YU OPPENHEIM**

She conducts the acclaimed 150-voice Canterbury Voices ensemble and shapes the artistic vision of OCU's four major choirs, including the Chamber Choir and Ad Astra women's chorus.

Dr. Yu's choirs have performed at prestigious venues such as Carnegie Hall, the National Cathedral in Washington, D.C., and internationally in Austria, Czech Republic, and France. She was an ACDA International Conducting Exchange Fellow to Kenya in 2019 and has led All-State choruses across the United States. Her expertise has been recognized through numerous awards and invitations to present at conferences.

A sought-after presenter, conductor, and clinician, Dr. Yu has shared her expertise at conferences of the American Choral Directors Association, National Association for Music Education, and European Music Educators Association. She holds degrees from the University of North Texas, Oklahoma State University, and the University of Central Oklahoma, solidifying her position as a respected leader in choral music education.


