After completing 18 months of flight training in Pensacola, Florida, Commander Menze was awarded her 'wings of gold' on June 24th, 2005. She became the first Black female aviator in the 215-year history of the United States Coast Guard. Menze then trained with the Air Force for three months while transitioning to the C-130 aircraft at Little Rock AFB in Arkansas. As of July 2017, CDR Menze is the Chief of HC-130H training at Aviation Training Center (ATC) Mobile, Alabama (detached duty Clearwater, Florida). At ATC, she is responsible for initial training, continued proficiency and standardization of crewmembers in all C-130H crew positions across the Coast Guard aviation fleet.

Alison (Ali) Wolpert serves as Managing Director, Global Government Relations at DTCC where she is responsible for leading the firm's global government relations strategy, focused on working collaboratively with government officials and industry organizations to share perspectives on matters that impact the organization's interests around the world. Prior to this role, Ali was Executive Director and Head of US Legislative Relations & Political Engagement, overseeing legislative and political outreach in Washington, D.C, including engagement with the United States Congress, regulators, and financial services industry representatives.
