Not talking about the skies, clouds, atmosphere

- Matthew 26:64 Jesus said to him, "You have said so. But I tell you, from now on you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of Power and coming on the clouds of heaven."
- 2 Cor 12.2 I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven—whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows.

Not talking about the kingdom of heaven.

- The kingdom of heaven is equated as being the church.
- Not talking about things in the New Testament described as heavenly.
 - Matthew 5:48 You therefore must be perfect, as your <u>heavenly Father</u> is perfect.

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Voices in Heaven

- Matt 3.16-17 And when Jesus was baptized, immediately he went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming to rest on him; (17) and behold, a voice from heaven said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."
- Mark 1.11 And <u>a voice came from heaven</u>, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."
- John 12.28 Father, glorify your name." Then <u>a voice came from</u> heaven: "I have glorified it, and I will glorify it again
- 2 Pet 1.18 we ourselves heard this very voice borne from heaven, for we were with him on the holy mountain

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Rewards in Heaven

- Matt 5.12 Rejoice and be glad, for your <u>reward is great in heaven</u>, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.
- Luke 6.22-23 22 "Blessed are you when people hate you and when they exclude you and revile you and spurn your name as evil, on account of the Son of Man! 23 Rejoice in that day, and leap for joy, for behold, your reward is great in heaven; for so their fathers did to the prophets.

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The Father is in Heaven

- Matt 5.16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your <u>Father who is in</u> heaven.
- Matthew 6:1 "Beware of practicing your righteousness before other people in order to be seen by them, for then you will have no reward from your <u>Father who is in heaven</u>.
- Matthew 6:9 Pray then like this: "Our <u>Father in heaven</u>, hallowed be your name.

 - Names are not given in the atmosphere or in space. It must be from God's Dwelling Place or on Earth.
- Acts 7.55-56 55 But he, full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God. 56 And he said, "Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God."

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God's Will Done in Heaven

- Matthew 6:10 Your kingdom come, <u>your will be done</u>, on earth <u>as it is</u> in heaven.
- Matt 11.25 At that time Jesus declared, "I thank you, Father, <u>Lord of heaven</u> and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children;

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Treasures in Heaven

- Matthew 6:20 but lay up for yourselves <u>treasures in heaven</u>, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal.
- Matt 19. 20-22 20 The young man said to him, "All these I have kept.
 What do I still lack?" 21 Jesus said to him, "If you would be perfect,
 go, sell what you possess and give to the poor, and you will have
 treasure in heaven; and come, follow me." 22 When the young man
 heard this he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.

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Exalted to Heaven

- Matt 11.23 And you, Capernaum, will you be exalted to heaven? You will be brought down to Hades. For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.
- Luke 10.15 And you, Capernaum, will you be <u>exalted to heaven?</u> You shall be brought down to Hades.
- Heb 7.26 For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and <u>exalted</u> above the heavens.

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Signs from Heaven

- Matt 16.11 And the Pharisees and Sadducees came, and to test him they asked him to show them <u>a sign from heaven.</u>
- Mark 8.11 The Pharisees came and began to argue with him, seeking from him a sign from heaven to test him.
- Luke 11.15-17 15 But some of them said, "He casts out demons by Beelzebul, the prince of demons," 16 while others, to test him, <u>kept</u> <u>seeking from him a sign from heaven.</u> 17 But he, knowing their thoughts, said to them, "Every kingdom divided against itself is laid waste, and a divided household falls.

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Angels in Heaven

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God's Throne is There

- Matt 5.34 But I say to you, Do not take an oath at all, either by heaven, for it is the throne of God,
- Matt 23.22 And whoever swears by heaven swears by the throne of God and by him who sits upon it.
 - James 5.12 But above all, my brothers, do not swear, either <u>by heaven</u> or by earth or by any other oath, but let your "yes" be yes and your "no" be no, so that you may not fall under condemnation.

 Acts 7.49 <u>Heaven is my throne</u>, and the earth is my footstool. What kind of house will you build for me, says the Lord, or what is the place of my rest?

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Righteous Taken to Heaven

- Matthew 25:31-46 "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. (32) Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. (33) And he will place the sheep on his right, but the goats on the left. (34) Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. (35) For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, (36) I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.' (37) Then the righteous will answer him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink?  - o The King (34) says "Come"
 - The King is in heaven; Jesus is in heaven.
 - o The righteous have eternal life
 - o The righteous are in heaven with Jesus
 - Therefore, Heaven is the place of eternal life.

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Authority in Heaven

- Matt 28.18 And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.
- Eph 1. 9-10 9 making known to us the mystery of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ (10) as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.
- Ephesians 3:14-15 For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, (15) from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named.
- Eph 6.9 Masters, do the same to them, and stop your threatening, knowing that he who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and that there is no partiality with him.

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Looking up to Heaven

 - Heaven is where God is

- Jesus was looking up toward his father when he prayed.
- Luke 9.16 And taking the five loaves and the two fish, <u>he looked</u> <u>up to heaven</u> and said a blessing over them. Then he broke the loaves and gave them to the disciples to set before the crowd.
 - He looked upward to the source of all blessings, God, who is in heaven
- Acts 7.55-56 55 But he, full of the Holy Spirit, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God. 56 And he said, "Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God."
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Jesus is in Heaven

- Mark 16.19 So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken <u>up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God.</u>
- John 3.31 He who comes <u>from above</u> is above all. He who is of the earth belongs to the earth and speaks in an earthly way. <u>He who</u> comes from heaven is above all.
- John 6.32-34 32 Jesus then said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, it was not Moses who gave you the bread from heaven, but my <u>Father gives you the true bread from heaven</u>. 33 For the bread of God is <u>he who comes down from heaven</u> and gives life to the world." 34 They said to him, "Sir, give us this bread always."

- Luke 10.20 Nevertheless, do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."
- Heb 12. 22-23 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering, 23 and to the assembly[a] of the <u>firstborn who are</u> <u>enrolled in heaven</u>, and <u>to God</u>, the judge of all, and to the <u>spirits of</u> <u>the righteous</u> made perfect,
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Joy in Heaven

• Luke 15.7 Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance.

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Sin Against Heaven

• Luke 15.18 I will arise and go to my father, and I will say to him, "Father, I have <u>sinned against heaven</u> and before you. Luke 15.21 And the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son.'

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Peace in Heaven

- Luke 19.38 saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"
- Colossians 3:1-2 If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. (2) Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.
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Ascend to Heaven / Descend from Heaven

- John 3.13 No one has ascended into heaven except he who descended from heaven, the Son of Man.
- John 3.31 He who comes <u>from above</u> is above all. He who is of the earth belongs to the earth and speaks in an earthly way. <u>He who</u> comes from heaven is above all.
- John 6.32-34 32 Jesus then said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, it was not Moses who gave you the bread from heaven, but my <u>Father gives you the true bread from heaven</u>. 33 For the bread of God is <u>he who comes down from heaven</u> and gives life to the world." 34 They said to him, "Sir, give us this bread always."
- John 6.38 For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me.
- John 6.49-51 49 Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died. 50 This is the bread that comes down from heaven, so that one may eat of it and not die. 51 I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh."
- John 6.58 This is the <u>bread that came down from heaven</u>, not like the bread the fathers ate, and died. Whoever feeds on this bread will live forever."
- John 14:1-3 "Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. (2) <u>In my Father's house</u> are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that <u>I go to prepare a place for</u>

- <u>you</u>? (3) And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and <u>will take you to myself</u>, that where I am you may be also.
- Acts 2.34 For <u>David did not ascend into the heavens</u>, but he himself says, "The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand,
- Acts 3.20-21 20 that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send the Christ appointed for you, Jesus, 21 whom heaven must receive until the time for restoring all the things about which God spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets long ago.
- Rom 10.5-7 5 For Moses writes about the righteousness that is based on the law, that the person who does the commandments shall live by them. 6 But the righteousness based on faith says, "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?" (that is, to bring Christ down) 7 "or 'Who will descend into the abyss?" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).
- Eph 4.10 He who descended is the one who also ascended <u>far above</u> <u>all the heavens</u>, that he might fill all things.)
- 1 Thess 4.16 For the Lord himself <u>will descend from heaven</u> with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.
- 2 Thess 1.7 and to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when the <u>Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven</u> with his <u>mighty</u> angels
- 1 Pet 1.12 It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you <u>by the Holy</u> <u>Spirit sent from heaven</u>, things into which angels long to look.

Eternal Life in Heaven

- John 3:36 Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.
 - To use this verse, it should be connected with heaven being a place of eternal life.
- John 5:28-29 Do not marvel at this, for an hour is coming when all
 who are in the tombs will hear his voice (29) and come out, those
 who have done good to the resurrection of life, and those who have
 done evil to the resurrection of judgment.

- 2 Cor 5.1-2 For we know that if the tent that is our earthly home is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, <u>eternal in the heavens</u>. (2) For in this tent we groan, longing to put on our heavenly dwelling,
- 1.5 because of the hope laid up <u>for you in heaven</u>. Of this you have heard before in the word of the truth, the gospel,

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So-Called "gods" in Heaven

1 Corinthians 8:4-6 Therefore, as to the eating of food offered to idols, we know that "an idol has no real existence," and that "there is no God but one." (5) For although there may be so-called gods in heaven or on earth—as indeed there are many "gods" and many "lords"— (6) yet for us there is one God, the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist, and one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom are all things and through whom we exist.

 Names are not given in the atmosphere or in space. It must be from God's Dwelling Place or on Earth.
