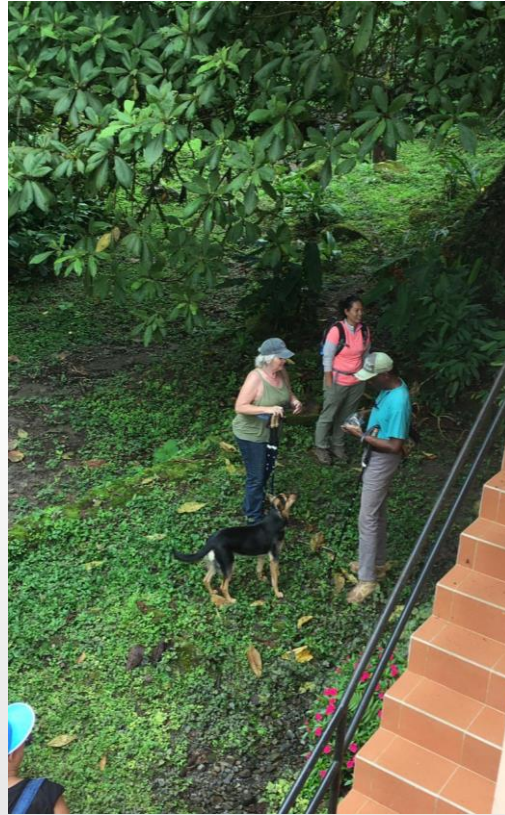


Our furry friends decided to play with the chickens much to the dismay of everyone.

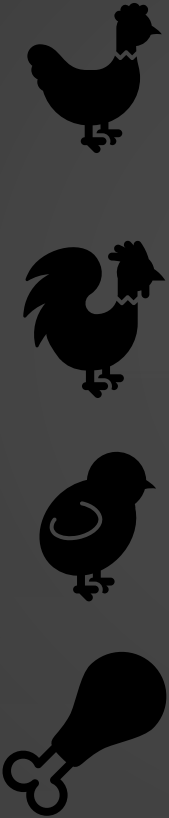
